#### **Texas District Education Weekend**

Good Morning Texas Gold Wingers!

The past 18+ months have had a big impact on our training opportunities. It seems like every time we think we are seeing a downturn in the pandemic levels and can start planning live Riding Courses, Seminars, and Modules, another strain pops up that forces us to become more cautious and explore ways to deliver training in a safer, alternative manner.

For the University, we offered 19 different Seminars and Modules online throughout the Spring and Summer of 2020. Classes ran two per day, five days a week, for six months and were attended by over 2000 participants. We currently have seven Texas Instructors that are certified for online instruction.

We are also promoting offering classes before or after Chapter Gatherings and during a Bike Clinic where members can attend a class in addition to working on bike maintenance. Remember, all University training is free and open to members and non-members alike (great recruitment tool). Riding Courses and Medic First Aid classes usually have a small charge to cover materials and expenses.

Finally, we have not held a District Education Weekend since 2019 but we hope to hold one this spring (possibly in March). We are in negotiations for a location and date and will release details as they are confirmed. In the past we have offered 1-2 Riding Classes, MFA classes, a Ride Captain class, Co-Rider class, and 3-4 seminar/modules. Depending on the response it can run one or two days. If you have a particular need or class you would like to see offered, please contact Dan Rymarz, Leo Smith, or Randy Reese with your suggestions.

After completing it, have your CD or any officer sign it, then submit it to me for approval and final processing at txed@gwrra-tx.org Whether signed up for the Levels Program or not, training in various motorcycle related areas is offered to all members. One of the main pillars of GWRRA is KNOWLEDGE. We gain knowledge through education, application and experience. GWRRA prides itself on offering training to promote safe riding skills, safer roadways and a better image of motorcycling overall. In the grand scheme of things we are all just one link in the chain. It takes more than just one link, one person or one District Educator to promote knowledge and safety in order to keep our organization strong. We all must do our part.

I want to thank all the wonderful instructors for volunteering your time and talents to keep us moving along.

Several members have contacted me requesting information from The Rider Education database. As of this writing it is currently down and under construction for upgrades. Please be patient, I am told it won't be too much longer before it is back up and running. At that time the Quarterly Levels Reports will be sent out. Don't let this hinder you from requesting training!

## Ride Coordinator

What is the role of a Chapter Ride Coordinator?

The focus of a Chapter Ride Coordinator needs to be on riding. The Chapter Ride Coordinator coordinates chapter rides. As an Officer, and part of the Rider Education Program, the Ride Coordinator needs to believe and participate in our Rider Education program and be at least

- 1) a Level 2
- 2) a Road Captain.

The role is not the same as the previous role of the Chapter Educator as there are no reports. Your energy and focus are on planning or helping assisting planning all variety of rides that suit your Chapter Participants.

As you get ready for a ride, you will conduct an informative Rider Meeting to encourage safety, i.e. vehicle inspections, group riding techniques, safety clothes and more.

You accept the Riders that show, and they need to be in compliance with State law.

You will encourage, communicate, and lead the way in sharing GWRRA's benefits of safety as developed through our Rider Education Program.

Keep in mind the reason we all own our motorcycles, the fun of being on the road and riding with our friends. You just make it safer and a lot more fun.
