Last month we announced that we were preparing to re-open Rider Education in Texas.

Our District Staff has elected to kick off our first statewide training opportunity by offering some Rider Ed. Seminars and modules at the Texas Yellow Rose Rally in Kerrville on April 28 - 30th. Dan & Donna, Sheri & I, and our entire staff plan on making visits to your Chapter social gatherings, where can pass on any information we have about other Chapters and their events or anything else happening in the District, Region, or Nationally including any information we have on other organizations. I will be reaching out to all Chapters in the State of Texas not matter what organization or not you belong to just like I did the last half of last year. So that anyone that wants to visit your Chapter they know when and where to find you. It is also a tool that if someone contacts us for a Chapter in their area we can point them to you, there again it does not matter what organization you belong to or not we want any rider that is interested in checking out any of the great Chapters in our state find a home


Take the time to volunteer and help your chapter, the more we work together the more we have fun!


