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From the District Director

Good afternoon and Happy July. The months are flying by and we are about 1/3 of the way through summer. It's been a little bit on the toasty side, but nothing that Texas isn't used to. We have been seeing many Facebook posts of our friends riding the roads across the U.S. exploring just like these motorcycles were designed to do. Like most summer months the advice we all give has to do with hydration and knowing your limitations in the heat, so this time we will not dwell on that. What we will talk about is the future. Many things are being planned for the rest of the year and we hope you will get an opportunity to participate. Last month when Groupworks shut down the question became how we will stay organized and communicate all the opportunities to the members of Texas. One of the chapters discovered a new website and phone app called GroupSpot (<https://www.groupspot.app/>) which appears to be even better than GroupWorks. A chapter can design their own security to limit unsolicited posts or open to the public in general. This will take place in Lindale, Texas which is a town just north of Tyler. Every evening we are planning something to eat, as well as sweet treats for those that attend. We have sent out invitations to over 200 previous attendees and EWMA members in Region B. We are hoping for a good turnout and we know we will have fun on some very enjoyable day rides. One of the best things about this is that at the end of September we usually have cooler temperatures as well as clear roads as no leaves will have fallen yet. THE TOPIC From NHTSA

On the Road

If you're ever in a serious motorcycle crash, the best hope you have for protecting your brain is a motorcycle helmet. Always wear a helmet that meets U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 218. Look for the DOT symbol on the outside back of the helmet. Snell and ANSI labels located inside the helmet also show that the helmet meets the standards of those private, non-profit organizations.

Arms and legs should be completely covered when riding a motorcycle, ideally by wearing leather or heavy denim. In addition to providing protection in a crash, protective gear also helps prevent dehydration. Boots or shoes should be high enough to cover your ankles, while gloves allow for a better grip and help protect your hands in the event of a crash. Wearing brightly colored clothing with reflective material will make you more visible to other vehicle drivers.

RIDE RESPONSIBLY

Experienced riders know local traffic laws - and they don't take risks. Obey traffic lights, signs, speed limits, and lane markings; ride with the flow of traffic and leave plenty of room between your bike and other vehicles; and always check behind you and signal before you change lanes. Remember to ride defensively. The majority of multi-vehicle motorcycle crashes generally are caused when other drivers simply didn't see the motorcyclist. Proceed cautiously at intersections and yield to pedestrians and other vehicles as appropriate. You can increase your visibility by applying reflective materials to your motorcycle and by keeping your motorcycle's headlights on at all times, even using high beams during the day.

BE ALCOHOL AND DRUG FREE

Alcohol and drugs, including some prescribed medications, negatively affect your judgment, coordination, balance, throttle control, and ability to shift gears. These substances also impair your alertness and reduce your reaction time. Even when you're fully alert, it's impossible to predict what other vehicles or pedestrians are going to do. Therefore, make sure you are alcohol and drug free when you get on your motorcycle. Otherwise, you'll be heading for trouble.

Ten Tips To Stay Cool While Riding In The Texas Heat

By now, you've probably seen the "excessive heat warnings" around Texas. Some see the heat as a reason to stay indoors while others still want to ride their motorcycles without this oppressive heat ruining all the fun. While Texas may lead the nation in heat-related deaths, you can still ride and stay (somewhat) cool during the "dog days of summer."

For starters, exposed skin dries out very quickly in the sun and wind. Yes, this can help with the cooling effect, but it also makes it harder to keep your body hydrated.

Keeping your arms covered (remember that synthetic long-sleeve T-shirt) helps reflect the sun's heat, prevents sunburn, and helps keep your sweat from evaporating too quickly.

Be smart and plan before you ride with these tips to stay cool while riding in the heat.

Stay Hydrated: This may sound obvious, but there are things we do that dehydrate us without even knowing. For example, alcohol and caffeine will, both, dehydrate you. If you need that cup of coffee before you hit the road, drink plenty of water along with it and on our cruiser bikes you can drink water while riding. Alcohol is a no-brainer. Leave the booze until the end of the ride, not while riding. When drinking water, the key is to drink small amounts frequently instead of a lot all at once. This will help you stay hydrated and cooler throughout the day.

Wear Wicking Clothing: Sweating is our body's way of regulating its temperature and when we wear synthetic base layers, that clothing helps wick away the sweat from our skin thus aiding in evaporative cooling.

Wear Full-Coverage Gear: You might think it's better to wear less clothes, but it's really not. The more skin you have exposed, the greater the chance you get burned. Even if you may not burn, exposure to the sun's UV rays can heat the skin and body. Couple that with lack of hydration and you're well on your way to heat exhaustion or even heat stroke. Wear long, breathable sleeves and pants to protect against the UV rays. Prolonged exposure to the sun can also dry out your skin which makes it more difficult to stay hydrated.

Wear a Cooling/Hydration Vest: Some of these vests can be dipped in water before wearing, which can keep your core from overheating. Other cooling vests have water in them to aid in cooling. I have one for these vests even with sleeves.

Wear Cooling Neck Wraps/Bandanas: Dip them in some water and wear them around your neck and arms to help cool you off. When they dry, make sure you get them wet again at your next stop. Both also have added protection against the sun as they're meant to cover exposed areas.

Avoid Riding During the Hottest Time of Day: Sometimes this can't be avoided, but most of the time you can plan your rides around the hottest part of the day. I have found out morning rides are great. Just be to your destination by noon,

Make Frequent Stops/Take Frequent Breaks: It's really easy to jump on your bike and "get in the zone" and ride for hours. During this excessive heat, it's best to stop frequently and enjoy some shade as much as possible. It'll help you and your bike cool down.

Wear Sunscreen: Another one of those no-brainers, but many of us only apply sunscreen just once. I apply it to the exposed areas every time I stop. Protecting your skin from sunburn will help keep you from suffering from the heat. Personally I find this to be a problem. First you should have all of your skin covered (ATGATT). Second never put sun screen on your face. When you get hot and start to sweat the sun screen may get in your eyes. If this happens you will not be able to see where you are going (Personal experience)

Wear a Helmet and Keep the Vents Open: Helmets save lives and can protect your head/face from exposure to the sun's UV rays. Much of our heat is released through our heads, so keep those helmet vents open to cool off some.

Wear Sunglasses: Our eyes are incredibly sensitive to UV rays and protecting them with proper eyewear can help keep you from feeling the miserable effects of the sun and heat.

As you can see, most of those tips deal with wearing the right clothing. I think most of us in EWMA have the gear. Just remember to wear All The Gear All The Time. For all you older folks like me I try to wait out the really hot weather and enjoy the AC.
